

## Full Year Guide

### Grade 9

- ☐ 6 Compulsory Courses: Complete 6 compulsory courses required for grade 9.
- ☐ 2 Electives: Take 2 elective courses (e.g., art and business).
- ☐ Summer School: Take a summer school class.

### Grade 10

- ☐ 6 Compulsory Courses: Complete 6 compulsory courses required for grade 10.
- ☐ 2 Electives: Take 2 elective courses, preferably one that is a prerequisite for a grade 11 course.
- ☐ Night School: Enroll in night school for a grade 12 course in the first semester and a grade 11 course in the second semester.
- ☐ Summer School: Take a grade 12 course that aligns with the grade 11 course taken in night school or day school.

### Grade 11 (First Semester)

- ☐ 3 Compulsory Courses: Take grade 11 English, Math, and a Religion course (if applicable).
- ☐ 1 Elective: Take an elective course that is a prerequisite for a grade 12 course or one that does not have a prerequisite.
- ☐ Night School: Continue with night school for a grade 12 course.

### Grade 11 (Second Semester)

- ☐ 3 Electives: Take 3 elective courses that will bring your marks up and be counted towards your top 6 for acceptance.

### Summer School (Between Grade 11 and 12):

- ☐ 1 Elective: Pick a grade 12 course that works coherently with the grade 11 course taken in night school or day school.

By the end of grade 11, you could have your 30 credits needed to graduate, one year early. Please verify this plan with your school counselor to ensure that this plan aligns with your future goals.
